

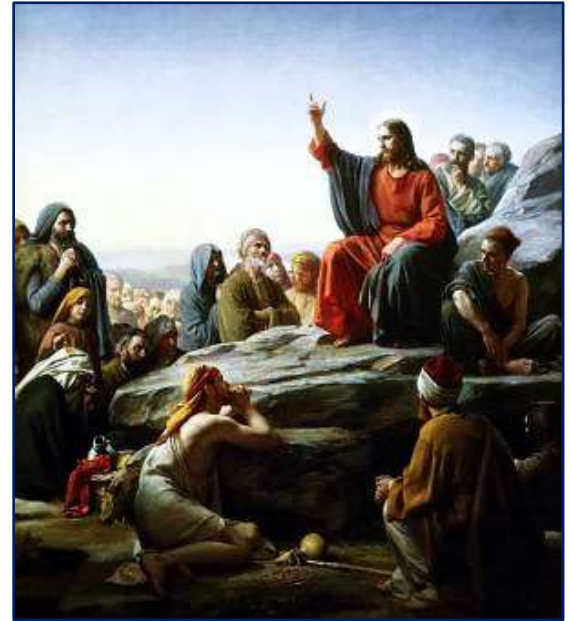
Religion in Art series continues March 8 at Groome Church
